



• There must be a written order from a physician detailing the name of the drug, dosage and the time interval the medicine should be taken. (This includes over-the-counter medications such as aspirin,

cough syrup, Tylenol-type remedies, etc.)

- Written permission from a parent or guardian of the student, requesting that the school district comply with the physician's order.
- Medications must be brought to school in a container appropriately labeled by the pharmacy or physician. The label must include the name of the person who is to take the medication, dosage, and time interim.
- If you need a "School Authorization Form for Medication" please contact the school health office and obtain one.
