Student Record Challenges

The parent(s)/guardian(s) may challenge the accuracy, relevancy or propriety of the records, except (1) grades, and (2) references to expulsions or out-of-school suspensions, if the challenge is made when the student's school records are being forwarded to another school. They have the right to request a hearing and to insert a written statement of reasonable length describing their position on disputed information. The school will include a copy of the statement in any release of the information in dispute. The Superintendent shall be responsible for establishing appropriate procedures.
