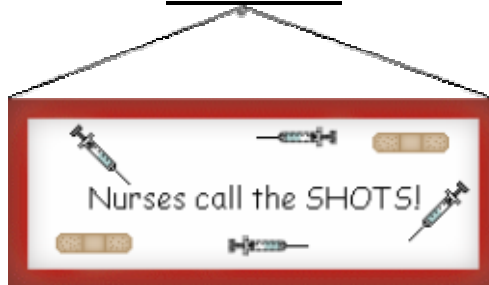


IMMUNIZATIONS SCHEDULE



VACCINE

Diphtheria - ages 2 thru Pre-K	4 or more doses ✓ First 3 doses at least 4 weeks apart ✓ 3rd and 4th doses at least 6 months apart
Diphtheria - KGN, 1st Grade	4 or more doses ✓ first 3 doses at least 4 weeks apart ✓ 3rd and 4th doses at least 6 months apart ✓ last dose on or after 4th birthday
Diphtheria - any other grade	3 or more doses ✓ first 2 doses at least 4 weeks apart ✓ 2nd and 3rd doses at least 6 months apart ✓ last dose on or after 4th birthday ✓
Pertussis - age 2 thru Pre-K	See Diphtheria Requirements
Pertussis - KGN, 1st Grade	See Diphtheria Requirements
Pertussis - any other grade	See Diphtheria Requirements ✓ Pertussis vaccine not medically recommended for children older than 7 years
Tetanus - age 2 thru Pre-K	See Diphtheria Requirements
Tetanus - KGN, 1st Grade	See Diphtheria Requirements
Tetanus - any other grade	See Diphtheria Requirements * If 10 years have passed since last booster, additional booster is required
Measles - age 2 thru Pre-K	1 dose on or after 1st birthday
Measles - Grades K - 12	2 doses of measles vaccine * 2nd dose at least 4 weeks after 1st dose
Rubella - ages 2 thru Grade 12	1 dose on or after 1st birthday
Mumps - ages 2 thru Grade 12	1 dose on or after 1st birthday
Haemophilus influenzae type b (hib)	See Appendix B on IDPH immunization web site as it varies with type used ✓ not required after age of 5 years
Hepatitis B - age 2 years thru Grade 4	3 doses required ✓ first 2 doses at least 4 weeks apart ✓ 2nd and 3rd doses at least 2 months apart ✓ 1st and 3rd doses at least 4 months apart ✓ 3rd dose after 6 months of age
Hepatitis B - 5th Grade and Up	3 doses required ✓ first 2 doses at least 4 weeks apart ✓ 2nd and 3rd doses at least 2 months apart ✓ 1st and 3rd doses at least 4 months apart
Varicella - age 2 years thru KGN	1 dose needed on or after 1st birthday or proof of disease
