The following details will assist as we navigate the coming weeks.

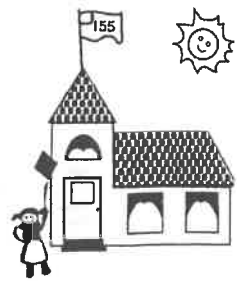
- On Monday, March 16, staff participated in a teacher institute day to complete eLearning plans to assure students will have access to learning materials.
- eLearning Days will begin on Tuesday, March 17 and continue through March 30, 2020.
- The District will reassess prior to March 30, 2020 to determine when on-campus classes will resume.

Students and staff should follow the approved eLearning plan that is posted on the District website.

- The eLearning plan can be found on the District homepage on the left hand side under quicklinks. The plan can also be found by scrolling over the academics tab at the top of the homepage.
- Students will be required to complete the assignments posted by their grade level teachers.
- Staff members will be working throughout the day with dedicated time from 8:45 AM – 12:00 PM and 12:30 PM to 3:30 PM to be online to answer student questions about assignments.
- Staff emails can be found on our website or by using the links provided in the eLearning Plan document.
- Hard copies of student work will be available for pick-up during designated times set by your school buildings staff. School building staff will communicate the pick-up schedule on Tuesday, March 17, 2020.
- Students should complete the eLearning plan attendance log with their parent/guardian's signature and submit it to their homeroom teacher when classes resume.
